



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
FACULTY OF LEARNING SCIENCES AND EDUCATION,  
THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY  
BANGKOK, THAILAND  
AND  
THE UNIVERSITY OF THE WEST OF ENGLAND  
BRISTOL, UNITED KINGDOM



The University of the West of England (“UWE Bristol”) and the Faculty of Learning Sciences and Education of Thammasat University (“LSEd”) agree that UWE provides two scholarship opportunities for highly talented Thai students from Thammasat Secondary School (“TSS”), a high school under the management of LSEd, to pursue a full-time undergraduate education at UWE. Details of the arrangement are set out as follows:

### 1. Scholarship Awards

- 1.1. UWE will provide two Half Tuition Scholarship awards to the qualified students of TSS for three year undergraduate programmes.
- 1.2. The value of Half Tuition Scholarship awards will be determined by the fees set by UWE Bristol on an annual basis. The award will represent 50% of the fee determined for each September intake. The scholarship shall take the form of a reduction in the tuition fee payable by the student and will be applied after the full tuition deposit has been paid by the applicant.
- 1.3 The scholarship awards are tenable up to three years, subject to an annual review of the student’s academic performance. Students will need to have passed all modules in the given academic year for a subsequent award to be made.

### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. An eligible nominee must be a current student from TSS and of Thai nationality. Should the student require to undertake a foundation award, the tuition scholarship will be held open until they are qualified to enter Year 1 of the undergraduate programme at UWE Bristol.
- 2.2 In order to apply for the scholarship awards, nominee should fulfill the academic achievements as deemed appropriate by LSEd.
- 2.3. Nominees should also fulfill all other programme-specific entrance requirements, including the required English proficiency, as stated by UWE (visit UWE’s homepage at <https://www.uwe.ac.uk/> for details). It should be noted that UWE Bristol are only able to provide scholarships for Year 1 of undergraduate programmes and not for foundation awards which are provided by a pathway provider.

### 3. Selection

- 3.1. Only nominations by LSEd will be considered.
- 3.2. LSEd shall nominate up two eligible applicants for Half Tuition Scholarship awards, if available, for UWE’s consideration and selection.
- 3.3. The Dean of LSEd shall recommend nominees or sign to endorse the counselor’s / teacher’s recommendations based on both the students’ academic and non-academic performances.

The present Memorandum comes into effect from the date of its signature by THE PARTIES and will remain valid for the period of three years. Either institution wishing to terminate this agreement shall notify the other institution in writing at least 6 (six) months prior to termination. Such notification shall not affect the status of students who have already been accepted for programmes initiated prior to the termination of this agreement.

Any decision to renew or renegotiate the terms of this agreement shall be made on the basis of consultations between the two institutions.


