## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between Mount Albert Grammar School, New Zealand and Thammasat Secondary School, Thailand

In order to promote further intercultural and educational exchanges, Thammasat Secondary School in Thailand (hereinafter referred to as 'TSS') and Mount Albert Grammar School in New Zealand (hereinafter referred to as 'MAGS') have agreed to enter an agreement of cooperation to establish programmes of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions. This agreement will serve as a general framework for cooperation between the two institutions.

In particular, the two institutions agree:

- a. to establish programmes that will enable interested and qualified students and staff from TSS and MAGS to pursue either short-term or extended programmes of study in each other's institutions;
- to assist, as far as possible, in arranging accommodation for the visiting students and staff from TSS and MAGS, and to assist the visiting students and staff from TSS and MAGS in matters of health, language, and local custom;
- c. to invite the other, when appropriate, to participate in conferences, symposia, and short visits in order to facilitate academic and cultural interchange;
- d. to identify other areas of possible interest and collaboration:

A designated person at each institution shall oversee and facilitate implementation of this agreement in cooperation with other appropriate administrators at the respective institutions.

The scope of activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by such other financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution.

The present Memorandum comes into effect from the date of its signature by THE PARTIES and will remain valid for the period of 5 (five) years. Either institution wishing to terminate this agreement shall notify the other institution in writing at least six (6) months prior to termination. Such notification shall not affect the status of students or staff who have already been accepted for programmes initiated prior to the termination of this agreement. Any decision to renew or renegotiate the terms of this agreement shall be made on the basis of consultations between the two institutions.

To facilitate the implementation of this agreement, NZ Study (Thailand) Co.,Ltd., the official representative of MAGS for Thailand, shall serve as a key intermediary and facilitator, working in conjunction with designated persons at each institution, to enhance collaboration and support the exchange programs.
